1. Performance of Commercial Airlines in MENA Region

This report, issued by the Research Department of Teaser Platform, analyzes the financial performance of 15 commercial airlines in the Middle East and North African region for the year ending in 2022.


A. Industry Performance

In 2020, none of the commercial airlines reported profits, while fifteen airlines reported aggregated losses of **USD -12.52 Billion**.

In 2021, nine airline companies reported an aggregated **USD 3.01 Billion** in net profits, while six companies reported aggregated losses of **USD -2.13 Billion**.


In 2022, nine airline companies reported an aggregated **USD 8.03 Billion** in net profits, growing by 166% on YoY basis, while four companies reported aggregated losses of **USD -335 Million**.

B. Top Performing MENA Airlines in 2022

The Emirates Group led the aviation sector in the MENA region reporting **USD 2.915 Billion** in net profit in 2022. Turkish Airlines led the aviation sector in Turkey reporting **USD 2.725 Billion** in net profit. Qatar Airways, a leading operator in Qatar, recorded **USD 1.19 Billion** in net profit. Lastly, Jazeera Airways led the aviation sector in Kuwait recording **USD 65 Million** in net profit.

2. Performance of Airport Service Companies in MENA Region

This segment of the report analyzes the financial performance of 20 airport service companies in the Middle East and North African region for the year ending in 2022.


A. Industry Performance

In 2020, nine airport service companies have reported an aggregated lump-sum of **USD 67 Million** in net profits, while eleven companies reported aggregated losses of **USD -1.20 Billion**.

In 2021, eighteen airport service companies reported **USD 378 Million** in net profits, a YoY increase of 464%, while two companies reported aggregated losses of **USD -85 Million**.

In 2022, eighteen airport service companies reported **USD 819 Million** in net profits, growing by 116% on YoY basis, while one company reported aggregated losses of **USD -65 Million**.

B. Top Performing MENA Airport Service Companies in 2022



TFS Akaryakıt Hizmetleri and TAV Havalimanlari led the airport services segment in the region reporting **USD 140 Million** and **USD 139 Million** in net profits in 2022, respectively. Abu Dhabi Aviation led the airport services segment in the UAE reporting **USD 112 Million** in net profit. National Air Services, the leading operator in Saudi Arabia, recorded **USD 69 Million** in net profit.


